

There are two entrances to the school premises and these gates will be open from 08:35:

- 1. School Lane (A)
- 2. High Street (B) please use crossing patrol to cross the road.

From 08:40 pupils may enter school through doors that lead in from the walkway nearest to the Broom (C) or doors to the rear of the school hall (D).

- Reception will enter school from the playground marked R on the map above this can be reached from either entrance A or B.
- Year 1 will enter school the same way that they entered Reception last year marked 1 on the map.
- Year 2 may enter school via C or D whichever is easier.
- Year 3 may enter school via C or D whichever is easier, although classrooms may have their doors open for entry too.
- Year 4 may enter school via C or D whichever is easier, although the cloakrooms will be open at entrance D.
- Year 5 and 6 enter their new building opposite entrance C.

We require all routes around school to flow freely – please use playground areas to stand in if waiting. Please keep children away from newly landscaped areas.

Gates will open at 15:10. From 15:15 pupils may be collected from the following places:

- Reception from the playground marked R on the map above.
- Year 1 from the playground marked 1 on the map above.
- Year 2 from the playground nearest to the High Street (B).
- Year 3 from the playground nearest to the Broom (C).
- Year 4 from the playground nearest to the High Street (B).
- Year 5 and 6 will exit school themselves or be collected from the playground nearest to the Broom (C).

If you have more than one pupil, we suggest you collect the youngest first. Timings in full below:
